**Jesus Said, "GO!"**

**Scripture - Matthew 28:16-20, 2 Corinthians 5:17-20**

### **Matthew 28:16-20 (ESV)**

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. **17** And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. **18** And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. **19** Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **20** teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

### **2 Corinthians 5:17-20 (ESV)**

**17** Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. **18** All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation; **19** that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation. **20** Therefore, we are ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We implore you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God.

**Main Idea** - Every person that we come in contact with will spend their eternity in one of two places - heaven or hell. God, who desires that none will perish, has placed the responsibility of telling the world about His Son Jesus on us, His children. The question then becomes, **what are we personally doing about the Great Commission?** Young and old it's all hands on deck for this all too important mission!

- What is the greatest challenge/ obstacle that you face when it comes to sharing your faith?
